Role Title: CCJF Regional Representative

Role Description: Working closely with the director and executive committee you will contribute to CCJF's position as the leading organisation working with churches and faith based voluntary groups in the UK on issues of criminal justice by:

- Arranging a minimum of two regional meetings a year
- To chair these meetings
- To act as the main contact for the region
- To represent the view of the region to local government and CCJF Executive committee
- To inform us to the organizations and churches working in criminal justice in your region

What is expected of a regional representative?

This role will take up to 2 to 3 days per month (time required will vary throughout the year). You will be expected to stay in phone and email contact and attend:

- CCJF National network meetings (normally twice a year)
- Annual regional planning / mid year review meeting

What do regional representatives get out of it?

- All of your travel expenses covered
- The chance to meet dozens of other activists in your region
- The experience of volunteering with the leading organisation working with churches and faith based voluntary groups in the UK

Person specification

All applicants must meet the following criteria:

- A member of CCJF or work experience in the field of criminal justice
- A desire for churches in your region to consider what they might do to further Criminal Justice issues in their communities.
- Access to the phone and the internet
- Commitment to meeting the expectations of a regional rep (outlined above).
